What is our Sin Problem?

Man has a natural desire to <u>SIN</u> and to ignore God's principles for living. We do our own thing and may say, "It's my life and I'll do what I please" or "If it feels good, do it — regardless of what God says".

Salvation

Can we earn Salvation?

- REGENERATION a change of nature from God
- REPENTANCE a change of mind about God
- CONVERSION a change of life for God
- ADOPTION a change of family in God
- •SANCTIFICATION a change of service unto God
- GLORIFICATION a change of place with God

What else did I receive at salvation?

- MERCY You did not get what you deserve
- <u>GRACE</u> You received what you did not deserve

What does God want me to do?

What is a Christian?

A Christian is someone who has heard the good news of the Gospel, has been convicted of sin, convinced by the Holy Spirit the need of a Savior. A Christian turns away from sin, and by God's grace, has been restored to a newness of life through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ.

WHAT IS EXPECTED OF ME AS A MEMBER?

At First Baptist Church we never ask our members to do more than the Bible clearly teaches. We only expect our members to do what the Bible commands every Christian to do. The process of becoming a church member may reflect the steps below before taking on responsibilities found in the Membership Church Covenants.

- RECEIVE Jesus Christ as Savior and profess Him as Lord
- OBEY the practice of Baptism and Discipleship
- JOIN a new members class to discuss the church statements, strategy and structure
- COMMIT my life of following Jesus Christ and serve as a member and disciple-maker

THE FOUR CHURCH COVENANTS

1.THE MEMBERSHIP COVENANT... is to Christ and to His Church.

"We are all parts of Christ's Body, and it takes every one of us to make it complete, for we each have different work to do. So we belong to each other and need all the others." Romans 12: 4-5 (LB)

2. THE MATURITY COVENANT... is to practice Habits necessary for growth. "Continue to grow in grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ."
2 Peter 3:18

"Take the time and trouble to keep yourself spiritually fit."

1 Timothy 4:7

3. THE MINISTRY COVENANT ... is to discover and use Spiritual gifts and abilities in Serving God and others.

"God has given each of you some special abilities; be sure to use them to help each other..." 1 Peter 4:10

4. THE MISSIONS COVENANT... is a to <u>Share</u> the Good News with others in my neighborhood and in all nations.

THE STRUCTURE OF FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH

The structure of the church should not be determined by culture, business practices, or even denominational traditions but its foundation is the biblical model and structure given by Christ's teachings and work of the Holy Spirit in the early Church leaders.

I. THE CHURCH IS A FELLOWSHIP.

Members Meetings allows you to cooperate with other believers by conducting church business and discuss ministry to advance the kingdom

II. THE CHURCH IS A FAMILY.

MEMBERS OPERATE ON THE BASIS OF RELATIONSHIPS NOT RULES.

"Don't reprimand a senior member of the church, appeal him as a father. Treat the young men as brothers, and the older women as mothers. Treat the younger women as sisters..." 1 Timothy 3:4-5

- The People are the "MINISTERS."
- The Pastors are the "ADMINISTRATORS."

DO WE AFFILIATE WITH A DENOMINATION?

As a church, we support three organizations voluntarily. Being a Southern Baptist Church means that we are an independent, local, Bible-believing church that chooses to cooperate with:

- The Orange County Baptist Association (Local)
- The California Baptist Convention (State-wide)
- The Southern Baptist Convention (Nation-wide)

What is the Southern Baptist Convention?

It is the largest association of Christian churches in California and in America.

One out of every ten churches in America is affiliated with the SBC, (40,000 churches and 15 million members - more than most other denominations combined).

What is our Statement of Faith?

This Church accepts "The Baptist Faith and Message" as most recently adopted by the Southern Baptist Convention as an affirmation of our basic Christian beliefs and as a general statement of our faith.

Autonomy of Each Local Church

Christ is the recognized head of our church, not any person, group, or religious organization. It is by the governing documents of this Church that we adhere to and should always be interpreted and applied in conformity with the Bible. While recognizing the value of associating and cooperating with other groups of Christians, we believe every local church should be self-governing and independent from any denominational control.

<u>Priesthood of Every Believer</u>

Ordinances

We practice baptism by immersion under water – the way Jesus was baptized, and the way the Bible commands.

We also regularly take of the Lord's Supper as symbolic service toward Christ's sacrifice of His death, burial and resurrection that gives believers the forgiveness of sins and salvation.


