Any-3 on One Page

- 1. GET CONNECTED (3-7 minutes): "Who are you?" and "How are you?"
- 2. GET TO A GOD CONVERSATION: "Are you Hindu, Muslim, Buddhist or Christian?" or "What are your religious beliefs?"

There are similarities in our religions", or "Almost all religions are alike, aren't they?"

- I. We're trying to please God, and we're trying to pay off our sins (get our sins forgiven)
- II. We're all sinners, aren't we?
 - 3. GET TO LOSTNESS: "What are you doing to pay off your sins (get your sins forgiven)?"
- I. Listen and ask inquisitive questions.
- II. Ask the three "admission questions"
 - A. Are your sins paid off (forgiven) yet?
 - B. When will they be paid off (forgiven)?
 - C. On Judgment Day, will they be paid off (forgiven) then?
 - **4. GET TO THE GOSPEL**: (The First and Last Sacrifice Story)

"What I believe is different. I know my sins are forgiven, not because I'm a good person, although I do try. My sins are forgiven because God Himself made a way for our sins to be forgiven." ...

Tell the First and Last Sacrifice Story

... "That's why I know my sins are forgiven, because God Himself made a way for our sins to be forgiven through Jesus."

- **5. GET TO A DECISION:** (*Draw the net and Arrange follow-up*)
- It makes sense doesn't it that we can't pay off our own sins, but God made a way for our sins to be forgiven through Jesus Christ?
- Have you ever heard this story before?
- Do you believe what I've told you about Christ paying for our sins?
 - i. If they aren't open, summarize what makes faith in Christ's sacrifice different from almost all other religions, and then move on.
 - ii. If they are open, but not yet professing faith, continue the conversation or set the follow-up visit.
 - iii. If they claim to believe the gospel, lead them to repent from sin and surrender themselves to Christ using Romans 10:9-10, and then pursue baptism.
