# CHILD PROTECTION

## ----- PLEASE READ -----

This coming year, we hope to expand our Children's Ministry in many ways. One of the ways we want to serve your family is through our new Child Protection trainings and policies. Our teachers and leaders have always taken a background check before serving with any minors, but we will now be expanding this to include a LiveScan through the California DOJ. This is due to a new law passed this last year.

We always have two background checked adults in the classroom at all times, and will continue that policy. Beginning this year, we will also be training all of our volunteers in a Child Protection course which teaches how to spot, report, and prevent child abuse. We hope to be good stewards of our time with your child, and be able to help them grow spiritually and keep them safe while in our care.

**How can you help keep your child safe?** While on our property, your child (any under 18) needs to be with their own parent/guardian at all times, unless they have been checked into a classroom with two trained adults. This includes during our fellowship meal times, and even going to the restroom during worship service. Because our facilities are open to the public during services, we cannot account for who may come inside, and may be in the bathroom or another room. Please stay with your child and help us keep them safe.
